- 1. This is a Level 1 Competition.
- 2. Judging will be conducted in accordance with the current A.F.L.A.C.A. *Competitor & Judging Manual* Issue No. 7, April 2006. Copies of the current manual are available for perusal at the Club Rooms.
- 3. There is no limit to the number of entries per Member in any section.
- 4. If, in the opinion of the Competition Committee there are insufficient entries in any section /s to constitute a satisfactory competition, then that or those sections may be combined with a similar section.
- 5. Faceted stones are to be entered in square boxes suitable for inclusion in display cases with material nominated.
- 6. Entry forms AND actual entries, other than Section O-17, can be submitted together. They may be:
 - left in the Entry box at the Club Rooms; or
 - posted to the Club to arrive no later than 27 September 2014. (NDLC P0 Box 59 Beecroft 2119); or
 - delivered to the Club Rooms from 12 noon 4 pm on Saturday 27 September 2014
- 7. Entries in Section 0-17 must be delivered to the Hall on Friday 24 October 2014 before 11pm.
- 8. Individual entries will be available for collection after the Exhibition at 6:00pm on 26 October 2014
- 9. <u>The Don Hudson Championship Shield</u> will be awarded to the Competitor(s) with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any five (5) of the following seven (7) sections: 1A, 1B, 2A, 8, 18B, 19A, or 25.
- 10. <u>The Past Presidents Cabochon Trophy</u> will be awarded to the Competitor(s) with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any four (4) of the following six (6) sections: 1A, 1BAA, 2B, 3, 4A and 13.
- 11. <u>The Jewellery Trophy</u> will be awarded to the Competitor with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any two (2) of the following three (3) sections: 18A, 18B or [one of either 19A or 19B].
- 12. <u>The Alec Campbell Faceting Trophy</u> will be awarded for the highest aggregate point score of the Entrant's best entry in any of the faceting sections 8A/B, 9A and 10.
- 13. <u>The Hugh & less Joyce Carving Trophy</u> will be awarded for the highest individual point score out of either the Open or Novice Carving Sections O-5A/B or N-5A/B. The entry must have been carved in the preceeding two years.
- 14. <u>The Mathew E. Staley Junior Trophy</u> will be awarded to the Junior Member with the highest aggregate point score of their best entry in any two of the junior sections 1A, 1B, 8A, 18E/F or 25.
